

## Drying Farrowing Rooms

(1/2 lb. per crate)

**Blow Mistral in farrowing room 30 minutes after power washing so powder will adhere to the moisture. Allow 20-30 minutes for Mistral to settle before activating ventilation.**

- ◆ The powder will speed up the drying process by absorbing moisture that pathogens need to survive.
- ◆ Mistral continues to lower the moisture levels throughout the farrowing cycle, lowering the bacteria load.
- ◆ Drying barns with Mistral helps managers better schedule labor, sows, and facilities.



## Special Applications

### Showing

**Apply Mistral in trailers, pens, and on animals in transit or after arrival at destination.**

- ◆ Mistral will lower the stress levels and keep them on normal feeding schedules.

### Boar Studs

**Sprinkle Mistral on floors, alley ways and crates to increase traction and lower bacteria levels.**

- ◆ Use Mistral as a sanitary aid in keeping facilities dry and pathogen counts low.

## Farrowing

(2 oz. per piglet)

**Piglet should be covered with Mistral by sprinkling or dipping at birth.**

- ◆ Mistral wicks away moisture off the newborn, while helping to maintain core body temperature.
- ◆ Piglets will suckle within the first 15 minutes after birth and consume up to three times the amount of colostrum due to energy saved from reducing chilling.
- ◆ Early colostrum intake will build a stronger immune system.



## On The Mats

(1 cup per day)

**Cover mats by dusting with powder at least 2 times per day for the first 5 days. Apply at two to three times the normal amount for scouring litters.**

- ◆ Piglets will be drawn to the warm, dry, powder covered mats where they will be safe from crushing. Increased footing will prevent leg injuries.
- ◆ Mistral will attach to the umbilical cord, reducing infections and accelerating the healing process. This will reduce navel ruptures in the future.
- ◆ Extra heavy application of Mistral will help shorten scouring issues.



## Transportation

(Several Pounds)

**Blow or dust a small amount over pigs after loading and before transportation begins.**

- ◆ Mistral will lessen the amount of fighting and tail biting that occurs because all animals will smell the same. The smell is familiar as they remember it from birth.
- ◆ The powder will also help keep the trailer, alley ways, and chutes dry and improve footing.

## Breeding & Gestation

(1/2 cup per day)

**Sprinkle Mistral behind the sow two days prior to breeding.**

- ◆ Powder will keep area dry and clean where the vulva comes in contact with the floor.
- ◆ Mistral will help keep the vulva area clean and reduce infections of the reproductive tract for improved farrowing rates.



## Nursery & Finishing Barns (Mixing Pigs)

(1 lb. per 150 sq. ft.)

**Blow or dust prior to loading and immediately after all pigs have moved into the new facility.**

- ◆ Mistral will dry the building which will lower the bacteria load and assist in fly control.
- ◆ The familiar smell reduces fighting and tailbiting and puts pigs on feed faster and easier.
- ◆ Mistral aids in reducing stress in all stages of production to keep animals healthier and maintain strong immune systems.
