Anticoagulant Brodifacoum: For animals ingesting bait and/or showing poisoning signs (bleeding or elevated prothrombin times), give Vitamin K1 at doses of 2-5 mg/kg. If needed, check prothrombin times every 3 days until values return to normal (up to 30 days). In severe cases, blood transfusions may be

RATS: Apply 3 to 16 ounces of bait (at intervals of 15 to 30 feet) per placement in infested areas. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 10 days or until signs of

rat activity cease MICE AND MEADOW VOLES*: Apply 1/4 to 1/2 oz. (1-2 level tablespoons) of bait per placement at 8 to 12 foot intervals in infested areas. Larger placements (up to 2 oz.) may be needed at points of

very high mouse or meadow vole* activity. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 15 days or until signs of mouse or meadow vole* activity cease.

FOLLOW-UP: Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Wearing gloves, collect and dispose of all dead, exposed animals and leftover bait. To prevent reinfestation, limit sources of rodent food, water, and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment. Where a continuous source of infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations and replenish as needed.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
