

WARNING



Read Carefully – These instructions are written to help prevent difficulties that might arise during installation of Comfort-Cove® heaters. Studying the instructions saves time.

TO REDUCE RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK:

- 1. Disconnect all power to heater at main service panel before wiring or servicing.
- 2. All wiring must be in accordance with the National Electrical Code.
- Verify the power supply voltage coming to heater matches the rating printed on the heater nameplate.
- 4. This heater is hot when in use. Do not touch.
- 5. Do not allow foreign objects to enter any ventilation opening.
- 6. Do not use it in areas where flammable liquids are used or stored.
- Use this heater only as described in this manual, any other use is not recommended by the manufacturer.
- 8. This heater is not approved for use in corrosive atmospheres.
- 9. The heater must be mounted at least 6' (182.8 cm) or (1.83 m) above the floor.
- 10. Refer to these instructions for top and bottom clearance requirements.


Comfort-Cove® Mounting & Clearances

- Locate a wall stud for each bracket such that when the heater is attached to the brackets they are spaced approximately 12" from heater end.
- Attach brackets to wall studs with wood screws provided, use template provided to mark screw locations depending upon type of ceiling. (Figure 1)
- Attach back shield to brackets by tilting Back Shield back and allowing Back Shield slot to fall onto bracket hook, then simply bring Back Shield forward locking into place.
- Hang Front Panel on Back Shield and complete wiring as directed. (Note: if left and or right clearance is restricted attach end caps to front panel before hanging)
- Complete wiring as shown on Page 3. Can be wired from either end.
- Secure Front Panel to Back Shield using supplied painted screws and Teflon washers.
- 7. Attach End Caps (Teflon washer not needed).
- Loosen the two outermost painted screws holding the painted Front Panel in place about one revolution, (this is to allow for thermal expansion).
- 9. When Comfort-Cove® is first energized, an initial breakin fragrance may be noticed – this is normal. (Do not touch while hot)












Comfort-Cove® Installation & Wiring







Commonly Asked Questions

Q. How do I clean the front panel if it gets a smudge?

A. Do not use chemicals of any kind. Simply take a clean, damp white cotton washcloth and wipe the surface clean.

Q. Can I paint the heater?

A. Never paint the heater with aftermarket paint. Contact factory to obtain approved coating materials.

Q. Which costs less to operate 120 volt or 240 volt?

A. Electricity is billed by kilowatt-hours, voltage makes no difference.

Q. What is the best mounting location, an interior, exterior wall or above a window?

A. You can mount on any wall, we simply recommend mounting where it is most convenient to wire and or appealing to the user.


Q. Where is the most efficient place to mount the thermostat?

A. Temperature controls are most accurate on interior walls. Mount where it is convenient to wire and for the user to operate. Do not mount directly above dimmer switches.
